

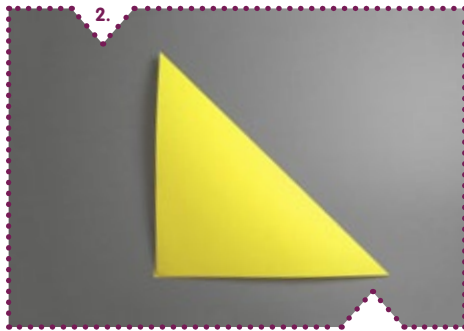
# Paper Lace



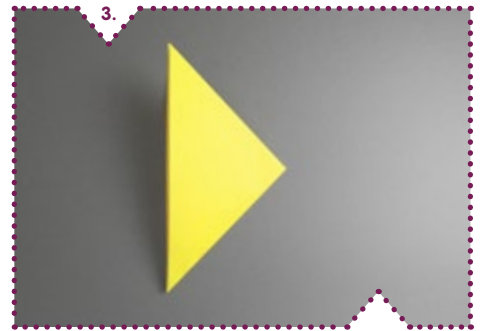
Cutting holes in paper or fabric is a quick way to make effective lace patterns. Try this idea to make some lace motifs that you could add to the wall of lace in the learning space. Try making some in different colours or textures, tissue paper works well, and over laying them on top of each other.



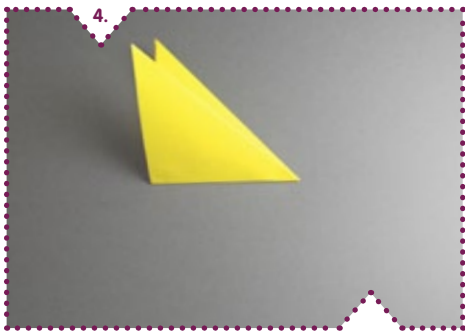
1. Start with a square and fold it in half diagonally. If using an A4 piece of paper, cut off the spare rectangle.



2. You will be left with a large triangle.



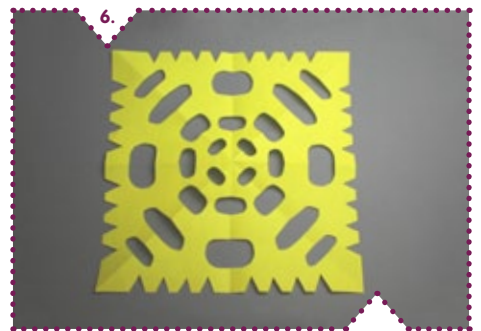
3. Fold the paper triangle in half.



4. And then in half again.



5. With the fold running vertically down the right hand side cut out the pattern as shown.



6. Open it up and it will look like this!
